Dribbling Scoring Rubric



Grades: 9th – 12th

Authentic Task: Students will work in small groups of 4 – 5 to work on various dribbling techniques for the game of basketball including (1) Pound Its using both hands, (2) Front V-Dribble, (3) Side V-Dribble, (4) Under One Leg, and (5) Front Crossover.

Instructions: Circle the category that each student fell within for the four criteria. Then write their total score here: _____

Criteria	Exceeds Expectations 5 pts.	Meets Expectations 3 pts.	Does Not Meet Expectations 1 pt.
Dribbling	Palm of the hand is kept off of the ball and the fingers are used for dribbling the ball the entire time. The ball was bounced with downward motion using the forearm and wrist.	Palm of the hand is kept off of the ball and the fingers are used for dribbling the ball most of the time. The ball was mainly bounced with downward motion using the forearm and wrist.	Palm of the hand is not kept off of the ball and the fingers were not mainly used to dribble the ball. The forearm and wrist were not properly used to bounce the ball with downward motion.
Alignment of the Body	The body was bent at the waist the entire time with flex knees. The dribbler kept head up at all times and eyes looking forward. The hand that was not dribbling the ball was kept out front and away from the body.	The body was bent at the waist most of the time with flex knees. The dribbler kept head up at all times and eyes looking forward, but looked at the ball occasionally. The hand that was not dribbling the ball was kept out front and away from the body.	The body was not bent at the waist the entire time and the knees did not remain flexed. The dribbler did not keep his/her head up at all times and eyes were not looking forward. The hand that was not dribbling the ball was not kept out front and away from the body for most of the dribble.
Completion of the Dribble	Flexed knees were maintained throughout the completion of the dribble. The body remained balanced and square to the next target.	Flexed knees were maintained throughout the completion of the dribble; however, the body did not remain balanced and square to the next target.	Flexed knees were not maintained throughout the completion of the entire dribble. Also, the body did not remain balanced and square to the next target.
Teamwork	Group member was cooperative, on task the entire time at the station, attentively watched other group members' demonstration, and provided constructive feedback to each group member.	Group member was cooperative, but off task at times at the station. The group member was attentive most of the time, and provided constructive feedback to majority of the other group members.	Group member was not cooperative at all times, did not remain on task the entire time at the station, did not attentively watched other group members' demonstration, and did provide constructive feedback to most of the other group members.
